Cerner PowerPlans may enable the practice to build treatment plans based on standard group orders for easier selection. PowerPlans group appropriate therapies together based upon disease, enabling consistency of care and efficiency of ordering.

MODIFYING AN EXISTING POWERPLAN

- Access **Oncology PowerPlans** and select desired PowerPlan
- Click **Add to Phase**
- Add additional medications as appropriate
- The added medication is now listed in the PowerPlan component grid
